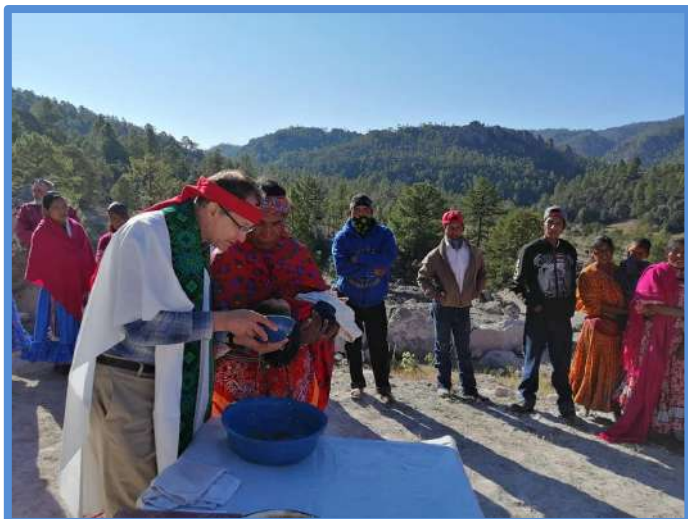

**Demographic Presence:**

CACSTAC is located in the town of Creel, Municipality of Bocoyna, Chihuahua, and serves residents of seven municipalities of the Sierra Tarahumara:

**Beneficiaries:**

- 95% of the beneficiaries are Rarámuri or Tarahumara indigenous people, originating from more than 220 communities located in the mountain municipalities, all of them with high or extreme
- Poverty, the majority lack services such as: electricity, drinking water, drainage, and communication router.

# SOCIAL CONTRIBUTION

Assistance projects in the area of health, food, education, care for the environment and promotion of culture.

## SANTA TERESITA CLINIC

- In external consultation 4,153 patients were treated Of which 3,036 Adults, 1,058 pediatrics and 59 emergencies.
- We had 332 hospitalized patients: 137 adults, 195 pediatric.
- We were able to offer the people a total of 7,773 days of hospital stay.
- 10,714 meals were served to relatives of patients and 4,876 to other people in need.
- We offered 1,045 laboratory studies.
- X-ray studies amounted to 816.
- We had 159 transfers: 89 adults and 70 pediatrics.
- A total of 97 pantries were distributed: 92 TB patients and 5 patients with Malnutrition.



## SCHOOL INTERCULTURAL BENÉSICA ANAGUPI in REJOGOCHI

- ✓ This 2021 we managed to return to eye classes.
- ✓ We are a recognized school, with Prestige. Quality education is provided.
- ✓ Increased Enrollment, from 80 to 100 students.
- ✓ Improvements in Health, through food and personal hygiene provided at school.
- ✓ We have a better Community Organization for various activities.
- ✓ We have two teachers from the institution in constant training in Carpentry.
- ✓ We promote the strengthening of culture.
- ✓ We monitor the orchard of fruit trees and the chicken coop.
- ✓ In December, Benefactors visited us and provided the children with jackets and shoes. A great help to get through the cold weather.

## JESUIT CULTURAL CENTERS OF THE TARAHUMARA

- Located in the communities of Guaguachique, Municipality of Guachochi; Pamachi Municipality of Urique; la Gavilana, in the Municipality of Batopilas.
- In the three centers, a total of approximately 50 children and a team of 4 Rarámuri teachers were worked on.
- Classes from Monday to Friday taught in Rarámuri and in the mother tongue to strengthen reading and writing.
- Activities for children focused on strengthening traditional culture and music.
- Resources and support were channeled to those most in need with a food supplement to combat malnutrition.
- There is the Jesuit backpack to deepen the reflection in the Indigenous Pastoral Assembly of the Tarahumara Diocese.

### EXCHANGE OF FOOD FOR COMMUNITY WORK

We served a total of 898 families from 12 communities corresponding to 3 municipalities.

- ✓ 10,900 kg of potatoes.
- ✓ 33,550 kg of corn.
- ✓ 1,500 kg wheat.

The benefited municipalities are: Bocoyna, Carichí, and Guachochi.

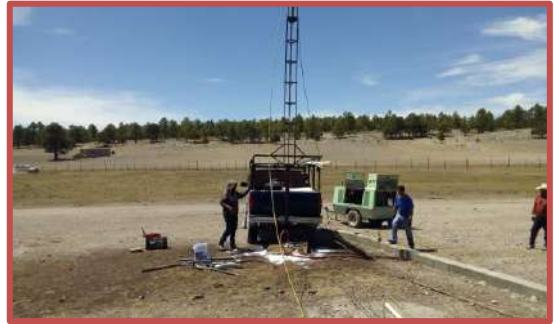

### MAINTENANCE PROJECT FOR WELLS, WATER HARVESTS AND ORCHARDS OF FRUIT TREES



In 2021, 21 wells in the Municipality of Bocoyna were kept in review and operational, One well was drilled. Approximately 906 people benefit from this.

- Moringa.

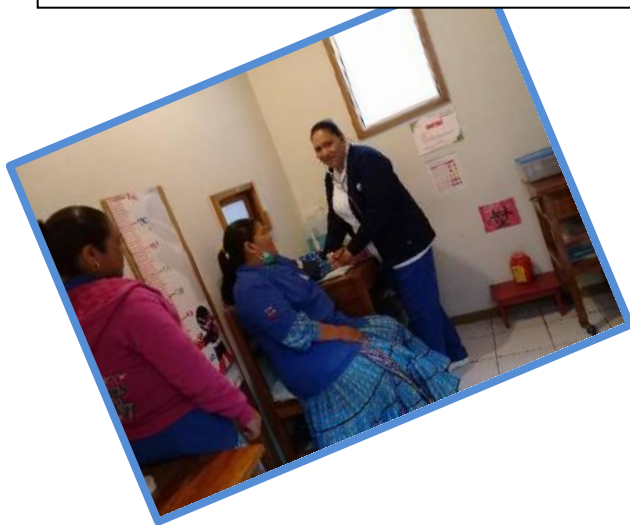
